



Afterschool Special Programs, Fall, 2010

Afterschool special programs are open to all students in the specified age/grade ranges, regardless of whether they are registered for the Extended Day program. Students are welcome to attend the regular Extended Day rooms on the day of their special program (at no charge) to have a supervised snack before the program begins. Staff members will make sure that they get safely to their special programs.

Cooking: “The Apple of Your Eye!”

For ages 8-12 Wednesdays, 3:30-5:00 8 Weeks (9/22-11/10) \$125

Join Montessori teacher Renee Anderson to explore the wonder of apples!

Bring home an apple dish (applesauce, Waldorf salad, apple brown betty etc.) each week to share at home. Then create a recipe of your own to share in our last session. Learn the legends and history of apples. Taste-testing, games and crafts will round out your apple experience!

Ballet and Jazz Combo 1 (ages 6-8) 4:25-5:20

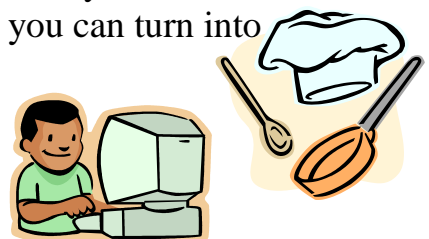

Each 30 minute class introduces the students to 3-5 core words, and the students interact with the vocabulary through music, movement, art and games. While the kids are playing, singing, dancing and making crafts, they are learning SPANISH! The students will receive a detailed newsletter each week highlighting the week's lesson. Each lesson is designed specifically for preschool & elementary aged children by certified teachers.

Rachel Domenick, registered yoga teacher with a certification in Kids Yoga, will be offering a six week yoga workshop. Children who practice yoga gain skills such as learning to calm and center themselves, pay attention and listen to their bodies, as well as the obvious physical benefits of flexibility and strength. We will be doing traditional yoga poses, but also taking yoga adventures and playing yoga games that encourage increased concentration and focus. This introduction to yoga is kid centered, making yoga both accessible and fun!





Art for ages 5 & 6

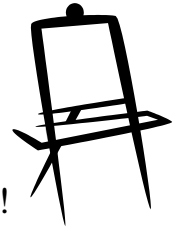
Wednesdays, 3:15-4:15 or 4:15-5:15 11 weeks (9/22-12/8) \$160
